As I told the 2017 festival attendees, I started this search in October 2016! The site we were ready to sign a contract with, was threatened with closure. The board felt that this was not the kind of situation we wanted to face at the last minute having to find an alternate site. The next site I found was almost perfect. We had contracts in hand and were about to sign when they had a better offer for a multi-year event and withdrew that contract. So the search goes on.

We are close to a contract with one site, but we are waiting until they can confirm some issues regarding classroom space and other issues.

Area 2 Endowment

You may or may not have heard about the Area 2 Endowment. Our Endowment was begun several years ago in order to help members of Area 2 financially through scholarships and gifts. Members of Area 2 are encouraged to apply for money to attend events, to start programs, to add on to existing programs and to further the art of handbell ringing throughout the Area. Area 2 sponsors several grants and scholarship programs which are funded through the Area 2 Endowment Fund, a part of the organization's charitable branch. Grant funds are made to Area 2 members, organizations and Area 2 subgroups for projects that support the mission of HMA and Area 2 and to encourage and support creative projects. Scholarship funds are distributed to qualifying applicants for individual scholarships to Area and National events.

A few things:

- The Area 2 Endowment was started by generous gifts from members and is now loosely sustained by interest, participation fees and gifts.
- You can give to the Endowment fund at any time by visiting our website.
- The Betty B. Garee Scholarship is awarded yearly to a first time director wanting to attend an event to further their craft.
- The Charlie P. Cramer Scholarship is awarded bi-yearly to a chaperone or support person to attend the Area 2 Festival Conference.
- Matching grants, start-up funds, equipment purchases, registration fees, refurbishing fees and other useful and worthwhile requests are all monies that can come from the Endowment.
- All scholarship and grant applications are funneled through an Endowment Committee with the Area 2 Board granting final approval.

This is an underutilized resource in the life of Area 2! Even though we have been able to award some grants and scholarships lately, there have been times where we have gone years without any requests. I urge you to apply if you feel it necessary. However, with more applications, there is more money going out. With more money going out, we need to make sure we keep the Endowment healthy by keeping the money coming in. I also urge you to give to the Endowment as you are able.

Challeng(R)ing is Coming!

Are you looking for a fun, yet challenging ringing experience this summer? Then join us for Challeng(R)ing 2018! This event is for adult and teen ringers. It allows ringers to challenge themselves to improve their ringing skills at their current level or to work on moving to the next level. Copper level ringers may want to stay at the Copper level or try the Bronze level. Bronze level ringers can work with the clinician to improve their current skills.

This year, the Challeng(R)ing will be held in two different locations on 2 consecutive weekends: Friday, August 3 and Saturday, August 4, we will be in the Rochester, NY area at Rush United Methodist Church.

August 10 and 11, we will be in the Harrisburg area at First United Methodist Church in Mechanicsburg.

We will be led by two amazing clinicians: Hyosang Park and Kathleen Ebling Shaw.

The event includes 2 options: Friday evening and Saturday, or just Saturday.

Friday includes classes in the afternoon. Dinner on Friday night is on your own. After dinner, we have planned a Friday evening concert followed by a dessert social and round-table discussions that allow the ringer to network with other ringers and discuss solutions for different challenges we all face.

Saturday is a full day of rehearsals and classes or reading sessions. Lunch is provided on Saturday. We will end the day with a mini concert where we can show off all that we have learned. Music is also included in the price. Housing and other meals are on your own, but we have arranged for special room rates at hotels in both locations.

At the New York session, we will also host a Music Education session on Friday morning that will be led by Bob Ward (our Area 2 chair and fearless leader). More information is forthcoming about that!

Register by June 25 to receive the best rates. Hotel reservations are due by July 1 at both locations in order to get the special rate. Registration information is available on the Area 2 website and in this newsletter. We hope to see you there!

This year's Challeng(R)ing will be held in two different locations, one week apart. One is near Rochester, NY and one near Harrisburg, PA. This one or two-day event is designed for the individual ringer, director, entire choir, or several members of a choir. Geared toward teens and adults, attendees will challenge themselves to improve their ringing skills and musicianship as they ring in a massed track. Classes and a reading session will also be available. The goal of the event is to allow ringers the opportunity to challenge themselves to ring at that next level of music or with greater technique, mastery, and musicality at their current level. Directors will gain valuable insight from the other side of the table on ringing, directing, and how to help their ringers and choirs improve and grow. Challenge yourself to ring for the moon and the stars!

Continuing Education Credits are offered to certified teachers in New Jersey and New York. (Due to changes in the regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Education, we are no longer an approved provider. Therefore, we cannot issue professional development credits for Pennsylvania teachers.)

MOON – for the ringer/director looking for a greater challenge and a chance to experience and/ or improve Bronze level music and techniques in a fun and friendly ringing environment.

Schedule Summary:

Friday will begin at 3:00 pm with two class sessions. Both technique classes and a music reading session will be offered. Dinner will be on your own. From 7:00 pm -9:00 pm, there will be a dessert reception and roundtable discussions – a wonderful opportunity to meet, network, and learn from other ringers/directors. The reception and round table is included in all registrations. RSVP is required on registration form for planning purposes.

Saturday will begin with your choice of a class or music reading session at 9:00 am. The massed track reading sessions begin at 10:30 am. Lunch is provided. The day will conclude with a mini-concert at 5:00 pm.

A detailed schedule will be sent to all participants.

Registration Fees: All registration fees for Challenge(R)ing include massed track ringing sessions, music, a Saturday morning class or music reading session, dessert reception and round table discussions on Friday night (RSVP required) and lunch on Saturday. Friday registration also includes two sessions of classes and/or a music reading session.

You Do Know About Endorsement, Right??

Do you host a great handbell event? Is it endorsed by Handbell Musicians of America? Why the bell not?

What IS endorsement?

Simply put, an endorsed event has the official thumbs up from Handbell Musicians of America (HMA). Any individual or organization belonging to HMA can submit an endorsement request for an educational handbell event. Workshops, festivals, reading sessions, seminars, and conferences are all classified as educational in nature. While the event must be presented by an HMA member, one does not necessarily need to be a member to attend the event.

Endorsement should not be confused with sponsorship. A *sponsored* event is an official event presented by HMA Area leadership - the biennial Area 2 Festival Conference, for example! Only HMA members can attend sponsored events.

Why should my event apply for endorsement?

Endorsement gives you the marketing and advertising power of the HMA national office. You can have your event listed on the national website as well as in the Overtones publication. For an area wide event, you can also request data for members in your target area so that you can contact or advertise to your target demographic directly. HMA will also cover ASCAP and mechanical licensing fees for your endorsed event. Legally, this is something you should already be attending to yourself!

Endorsement also gives you the structured legitimacy of our national organization. By joining your event with the larger HMA community, you contribute your fellowship to the musical art of handbell ringing. We are a small community when compared to the choral, orchestral, or band world, but we are strong and vibrant because of the dedication and enthusiasm of members.

How do I apply for endorsement?

Forms for endorsement application are available on the national website, www.handbellmusicians.org.
There is a convenient search function at the bottom of the home page to assist your navigation if you're having trouble locating the forms. Completed forms are reviewed and approved by Bob Ward, Chair of Area 2, before they are passed on to the national office. Bob can be reached at chair.area2@handbellmusicians.org.

Applications will be accepted until all sets have been allocated for Summer 2018 and the school year 2018-2019. Contact the HMA CHIME Chair about set availability.

Handchime Lending Program:

The purpose of HMA Area 2's Handchime Lending Program is to promote the ringing of handchimes in Public or Private Elementary or Secondary schools, Churches, or Community Groups within our area of Pennsylvania, New York, New Jersey and Ontario. This program is a valuable introduction to the art of ringing instruments and often becomes a focal point in expanding such programs in the local community.



About the Loan Program

HMA Area 2 has 5 sets of three-octave handchimes to loan.

The loan periods are:

One (1) school year (September 1 through June with return of handchimes to Area2 by June 15, 2019.

-OR-

One (1) summer session (July 1 – August 15) with return of handchimes to Area 2 by August 22, 2019.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Public or Private Elementary or Secondary school, Church, or Community Group within area II of HMA.
- 2. Handchimes will be loaned only once to a particular school, church or group.
- 3. Preference will be given to a new school district before another school within the same district.
- 4. Preference will be given to organizations with existing music programs.
- 5. Must be a member of HMA, or willing to become a member of HMA if loan is approved.
