

Celebration of Life for Marilyn M. Hines

Memorial services tend to be solemn affairs. Marilyn's wasn't, but no surprise there!

It was a time of celebrating a life that effected many people - and they were all happy to tell you about it. The service also brought together people who hadn't seen each other in years, fondly reminiscing about Marilyn. It almost seemed like Marilyn was among us.

Marilyn's exposure to handbells began in the late 1960's. Suffice it to say, the rest is history. She organized The North Hills Handbell Festival, served on the Area 2 Board as Chairman, and then on to the national scene as President of AGEHR from 1991-1993. She was awarded the Lifetime Member Award in 2003 in recognition of her leadership. Remembrances and stories were read from those who could not attend. Those in the congregation offered their stories, too. Through it all, the essence of Marilyn shone through like a shining star.

Five Area 2 Past chairs were in attendance: Howard Moser and his wife, Carol; Janice Peters; Carol Roman; Jim Rossetti and his wife, Mary Rita; and Bob Ward.
