

Spring Ring, 2024

We will be holding our first Spring Ring in March, 2024. This event is for Level 1 and 2 ringers and choirs. It is a massed ring event with Kathy Ebling Shaw as our clinician. It will be held **Saturday, March 16** at Proclamation Presbyterian Church in Bryn Mawr, PA. The hours are 9am-3pm. Registration and set-up will open at 8am. Lunch will be provided.

We will be working on 4 pieces that are appropriate for use throughout the church year. (This was decided in order to be respectful of your music budgets as well as your rehearsal time.) Ringers should prepare in advance in order to get the most out of our time with Kathy.

Cost is \$35 per ringer. Registration forms are available on the Area 2 website along with a list of the chosen repertoire. You can register as a full choir or as an individual ringer. You should plan to bring your own tables, pads, bells, mallets, and music to the event. You can also register and pay online with this link: https://bit.ly/springring24

Please note, space for this event is limited to 30-35 ringers, so register early in order to assure a spot. Individual ringers will be assigned a spot within a full choir if possible, so your parts will be assigned as soon as we know what openings are available within the choirs. Directors: please be sure to note if you will have openings in your group when you register.

We look forward to seeing you there! This is a great opportunity for ringers to work with an amazing clinician and educator.

2025 Festival Conference Composition Contest



Prize: \$1,000.00

The composition should meet the following criteria:

- · An original handbell composition suitable for massed ringing
- 3-5 octaves, HMA Level 2 3
- Optional handchimes or other instruments may be used
- Performance time not to exceed 4.5 minutes

Deadline: April 15, 2024

- 1. Please use HMA/AGEHR publication Handbell Notation and Grading System as a reference guide for all compositional notation.
- 2. Composers may enter as many manuscripts as they wish, but each is to be sent under a separate cover letter.
- 3. To enter, send a cover letter, manuscript PDF file, and MP3 audio of the piece. Prepare a cover letter containing: Title, intended playing time, composer's name, address, phone, and email address. The manuscript of the piece should include: Title, category, bells used chart, optional instructions, and duration. DO NOT INCLUDE THE COMPOSER'S NAME ON ANY MANUSCRIPT PAGE. Submit cover letter, manuscript, and MP3 together in a single mailed packet or email.
- 4. Decision of the judges is final. Area 2 reserves the right to select an entry that, in our sole judgment, is suitable for Festival purpose. Area 2 reserves the right to not award a prize.
- 5. Winning entries will be performed at the 2025 Festival Conference.
- 6. Area 2 will request a suitable dedication line when the composition is published. Area 2 reserves the right to be the sole dedicatee.
- 7. Winning composition may not be presented or performed in any festival, area, or local event prior to the 2025 Area 2 Festival Conference.
- 8. Area 2 adheres to copyright laws. Copyright obligations and adherence to copyright law is expected of all composers.
- 9. ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED OR SUBMITTED VIA EMAIL BY APRIL 15, 2024.

ONLY ORIGINAL, UNPUBLISHED WORKS MAY BE SUBMITTED
WORKS THAT INCLUDE ARRANGEMENTS OF EXISTING TUNES WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

Entries may not be under consideration by any other contest or publisher while being considered by Area 2. Failure to observe this clause will result in immediate forfeiture of any prize awarded.

ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED OR SUBMITTED VIA EMAIL BY APRIL 15, 2024.
