
What do you receive for your Festival Conference registration fee?

Your registration fee includes:

Jason is a full-time freelance composer, arranger, clinician, and teacher. Since his first publication in 2006, he's had over 700 compositions and arrangements accepted for handbells, piano, strings, organ, and choir. His works have been featured at numerous festivals and workshops in the United States and beyond. He is also handbell editor for Beckenhorst Press, as well as the owner of and editor for Grassy Meadow Music.

Michael Helman is currently Director of Music/Organist at Brevard-Davidson River Presbyterian Church in Brevard, North Carolina where he directs the Chancel choir, Westminster Ringers and coordinates a concert series. Michael is also an adjunct faculty member at Brevard College. Prior to moving to North Carolina, Michael served churches in Hockessin and Wilmington, Delaware and most recently was Director of Music/Organist for sixteen years at Faith Presbyterian in Cape Coral, Florida. He holds a degree in organ performance from Lebanon Valley College and a graduate degree in

He has spent several years working on a young adult fantasy series, *The Sadonian Chronicles*, and has released a non-fiction book, *The General Theory of Creativity*. 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Kathy Ebling Shaw
Tins Track Conductor

Kathleen Ebling Shaw is well known as a handbell clinician. She has conducted sessions for the International Handbell Symposia in Japan, England, Korea, Australia and the US and for the Handbell Musicians of America both on the local and national levels. Other engagements have included sessions for the American Guild of Organists; various State music conferences; Choristers Guild; Presbyterian Association of Musicians Conferences; Lutheridge Music & Worship Week and the St. Olaf Church Music Conference.

Mrs. Shaw serves as Vice President of Malmark Bells, Inc. She recently retired as the Conductor of the Westminster Concert Bell Choir and member of the Performance Studies Department at Westminster Choir College of Rider University. For 33 years, she taught classes in handbell training and conducted the handbell choirs. A graduate of the college, she is also the recipient of an Alumni Merit Award from Westminster Choir College of Rider University in recognition of her dedication to the art of handbell ringing and her enthusiasm and accomplishments in the classroom as well as the concert hall.

Under the direction of Mrs. Shaw, The Westminster Concert Bell Choir made its Carnegie Hall debut in December 2001 as the first American handbell ensemble to perform there. She also conducted the group on Lifetime Television, QVC, NBC's TODAY Show, New Jersey Network, Mister Rogers' Neighborhood, NPR and NBC's nationally televised Lighting of the Rockefeller Center Christmas Tree with Josh Groban. She traveled with the Westminster Concert Bell Choir during a critically acclaimed 15-city North American "A Royal Christmas" tour, performing with Julie Andrews, Christopher Plummer, Charlotte Church and the Royal Philharmonic Concert Orchestra. She has also produced eight recordings with the choir.

for completing your registration

- Please make a copy of all forms for your records. Be sure to mail the original.
- Each registration form must be signed by an authorized adult (director of the choir, pastor, etc.), acknowledging the refund policy where indicated on the enclosed form. Forms not signed will be returned.
- Refund Policy—If cancellation of your registration is made prior to June 1, 2025, Area 2 will refund all registration fees paid **except** the \$75 per person deposit. If the cancellation is made after June 1, 2025, **NO FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.**
- Area 2 adheres to copyright laws. Absolutely no copies of music may be used at the festival. Area 2 reserves all surprise inspection rights.
- When making your housing plans, please remember one chaperone, 21 years or older, must accompany every 6 ringers of the same gender under age 18. Additional information will be made available to you.
- Placement on the ringing floor is determined by the date your **payment in full** is received.
- Information on class pre-registration will be sent in early spring.

Registration Information

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT: The Early Bird Discount is offered only to HMA members only. To take advantage of the Early Bird Discount, registrants must meet the following two deadlines:

1. Total balance due for each participant in the group/individual attending must be POSTMARKED by the following dates in order to qualify for the graduated discounts:

\$300 (\$50 per person discount) if registration by 1/15/2025 \$325 (\$25 per person discount) if registration by 2/28/2025 \$350 (\$0 discount) for any registration received or paid on 3/1/25 or later. (Non-members pay the full \$350 fee regardless of date registration is received.

2. All registrations must be POSTMARKED by May 31, 2025.

Failure to meet these postmark dates will cancel the discount and result in ALL registrant fees being due based on the Postmark requirements of May 31, 2025.

Handbell Musicians of America Fee Requirements: to be eligible for early-bird registration fees, all participating choirs and individuals in the 2025 Festival must be members of the Handbell Musicians of America. Handbell Musicians of America membership helps to offset costs incurred by both the Area and National (e.g. insurance, royalties, etc.). Directors (or the organization they represent) or individuals who are not currently members of Handbell Musicians of America may attend the Festival Conference but do not qualify for early-bird discounts. Individual ringers are covered if their director or organization is a member. Your individual or organization membership number must be included on the registration. It can be found on your *Overtones* label.

Membership: For those who wish to join the organization before registering, membership information can be found on the National website: www.handbellmusicians.org. Click on the membership tab and follow instructions.

Festival T-shirts and Polo Shirts: Shirts are not included in the registration fee. Festival shirts will be available for purchase online. If you wish to order a shirt, you may do so using the link included in the Festival packet information to be emailed to you after your registration has been processed.

For your convenience, the Festival Packet and all registration information will be available on the Area 2 website. You are encouraged to use this resource to help Area 2 save on postage costs.
